1	Oral Presentation	Oral lecture. The content is new and still unpublished. 15 min. lecture plus 5 min. questions. IMPORTANT: A full-reviewed or an non-reviewed manuscript for the conference proceedings must be handed in for the lecture (see 6 and 7 for types of papers)!	2 channel stereo public address system and video projection
2	Poster Presentation	Results from scientific and practical work are presented and discussed by means of posters. Speakers present a paper, students discuss diploma theses, exhibiting companies present new products. The authors are present at fixed times and explain their posters. The presenters are asked to hand in a full-reviewed or non-reviewed manuscript (see 6 and 7 for types of papers).	Poster screen in size 100 cm x 70 cm (portrait format)
3	Workshop	Focus on practical work and for presentations with many audio examples. 25 or 55 min. workshop plus 5 min. questions and answers. The submission of a non-reviewed manuscript (see 7) or a collection of slides in pdf-format for the conference proceedings is possible.	Stereo or surround sound for audio playback. Please specify the audio format you need. A video projection is possible.
4	3D Audio Competition	The Call for the Competition takes place externally. Student 3D Audio Production Competition in Ambisonics: For the third time already, the Student 3D Audio Competition brings high-quality, elaborate productions to the ears. In English language.	Surround sound audio playback (Ambisonics). A video projection is possible.

IMPORTANT: The manuscript (max. 8 pages in our template format) must be submitted for the review process by 9th of June 2019! This type of paper can be chosen for 1,2, and 3. 7	Non-Reviewed Paper	A manuscript in English or German language. The content should be new and unpublished. IMPORTANT: A title and an abstract (max. 250 words) must be submitted by 9th of June 2019! The abstract is reviewed in the sense of a fundamental comprehensibility of the content. The full manuscript (max. 8 pages in our template format) must be submitted by 2nd of August 2019!
